

Know Your Signs and Signals

Unscramble the words below to discover the names of warning signs and signals commonly found near the railroad tracks.



SRSCBCOKU

Marks a crossing and should be considered the same as a YIELD. This is the most common sign at public highway-rail intersections.



EMNGCEYRE OINIFTCONTIA

Shows the railroad's emergency phone number and USDOT Crossing Number. This is the first phone number to call if your car is stuck on the tracks. If it is missing call 911. Each crossing in the USA has a unique USDOT Crossing Number.



ELMPUITL CRTKA

Indicates the number of tracks present. After one train has passed, look and listen for another train coming from either direction.



NADAVCE NNARWGI

Warns drivers that the road crosses railroad tracks ahead. Reminds the driver to slow down, look and listen for a train.



LWO DNGRUO ECLRAENCA

Alerts drivers of long wheelbase vehicles or trailers of a potential hang-up situation at the crossing.



FLIAHSGN DER ITSHLG

Warns drivers that the road crosses railroad tracks ahead. Reminds the driver to slow down, look and listen for a train.
