## Did You Know?

- There are 15 NM Rail Runner stations between Belen and Santa Fe.
- Placing objects on the tracks is dangerous; you could get hurt or even derail the train.
- Trains run in both directions. Always be aware of your surroundings near the tracks.
- Not every train crossing is marked with warning bells, lights or gates.
- It can take a train a mile or more to stop. If the engineer can see you on the track, it is already too late to stop.
- The Rail Runner passes through more than 100 crossings along the corridor.
- Walking on or near the train track is illegal.
- ► The average train car is 85 feet long and weighs 120 tons (240,000 lbs) - the equivalent of 30 elephants!
- ▶ Top speed for the Rail Runner is 79 mph.
- There is a red emergency call button located on the kiosk at every Rail Runner station.
