



**R-26-02 RMRTD
DISPOSITION OF RMRTD VEHICLES**

1 **WHEREAS**, staff have identified nine (9) vehicles owned by the Rio Metro
2 Regional Transit District (RMRTD) shown in the Inspection and Condemnation Report /
3 Fixed Asset Transfer (Attachment A) to have a current resale value of (\$5,000) or less
4 and to be worn out, unusable or obsolete to the extent they are not economical or safe
5 for continued use for their needed purpose; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Section 13-6-1 and 13-6-2 NMSA 1978 govern the disposition of
7 obsolete, worn-out or unusable tangible personal property owned by local publicbodies;
8 and

9 **WHEREAS**, Resolution R-21-07 RMRTD passed by the RMRTD Board of
10 Directors on September 17, 2021, established the Property Disposal Standing
11 Committee; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the RMRTD Property Disposal Standing Committee met on
13 December 12, 2025, and unanimously agreed to dispose the nine (9) vehicles listed on
14 the Inspection and Condemnation Report / Fixed Asset Transfer Form (Attachment A).

15 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE RMRTD BOARD OF**
16 **DIRECTORS,**


17 1. That the RMRTD Board of Directors hereby finds the following vehicles
18 identified in the Inspection and Condemnation Report / Fixed Asset Transfer
19 Form (Attachment A) to be worn-out, unusable, or obsolete to the degree that

20 it is no longer economical to maintain as part of the RMRTD fleet and has a
21 current resale value of less than \$5,000:



31 2. That the RMRTD Board of Directors authorizes the Chief Executive Officer
32 (CEO) to proceed with the disposal of the vehicles and delete them from the
33 public inventory; and further directs the CEO to send a copy of the official finding
34 and proposed disposition to the State Auditor and the Local Government Division
35 of the Department of Finance and Administration 30 days before the deletion of
36 the vehicle from the RMRTD public inventory. The copy of the board's official
37 finding and proposed disposition shall be duly sworn and subscribed under oath
38 by each member of the RMRTD Board appointed to approve the action (RMRTD
39 Property Disposal Standing Committee).
